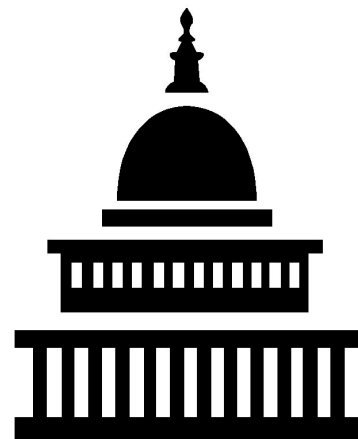

They determine what, given the financial and human resources available, the State PTA will monitor and attempt to affect/influence through supporting, opposing, or writing legislation, as well as working with other groups, coalitions, and organizations.
