



## Reflections Information

### Entry Size Qualifiers

This handy board helps during the entry verification. If you make this out of heavier cardboard it can be used for many years. With this all the size guess work goes right out the door.

The dimensions for the cardboard template are from the National PTA entry criteria.

- Cut a piece of cardboard 30" x 24". This is the largest a **Visual Arts** entry can be.
- Draw a 11" x 14" rectangle in one corner of the rectangle. This is the largest a **Photography** entry can be with a photo and mat.
- Then cut a 3/8" wide slit toward the top portion of the large rectangle that is 24" across so you can slide the **Visual Arts/Photography** entries through the slot. This will allow you to check if they are flat enough to be entered. No Visual Arts or Photography entry can be more than 3/8" in height from the surface--so no pom poms, macaroni art, beans glued on, or multiple mats that make the art too thick.
