

Award Outline

The Outstanding E-blast award recognizes local PTA, community PTA, and council e-blasts. An E-blast is considered to be a regular email communication to members. Electronic newsletters are a different award application.

Award Instructions & Information

Use this application only. Do not alter.

- This application form is for local PTAs, community PTAs, and councils.
- Please include only this Outstanding E-blast application page with your submission. Subsequent judging form pages are to be used as a guide in creating your submission and do not need to be included.
- E-blasts will be judged on PTA identification, content, overall appearance, and creativity.
- PTAs must be in good standing with WSPTA in order to participate in the WSPTA Local PTA and Council Awards of Excellence.
- Submit application and requested pages in **one** 3-ring binder.
- Submissions that do not include the completed application page and required e-blast examples will not be judged.
- Include **ONLY** the number of items requested. Please do not include more e-blast examples than requested.
- Award time frame is from March 1, 2018 – February 28, 2019 unless otherwise noted. Do not include old examples.
- Partial credit may be awarded if deemed appropriate by the judging committee.
- Decisions of Outstanding E-blast Committee and WSPTA Program Director are final.
- Awards will be presented at the 2019 WSPTA Convention.

E-blast Submission

- This application **must** include printed copies of **three (3) calendar months'** worth of publications. You may choose any three months from the March 1, 2018 through February 28, 2019 time frame. The months do not need to be consecutive. Please include all issues from your chosen months, but do not include issues outside of the three months you have chosen to submit.
 - If e-blasts are monthly, then send in three (3) issues – one per month
 - If e-blast are sent twice a month, then send in six (6) issues – two per month
 - If e-blasts are weekly, then send in twelve (12) issues – four per month
- Please send the e-blasts in the original format it was sent to your members. Do not alter or highlight any areas of the e-blast. Judges will review all newsletter and e-blast examples for the required information.
- Exception: Some online e-blast programs do not print a date; you may handwrite the date on top of the printed e-blast.
