

## WSPTA Testimony on HB 1351

## Jan 29, 2019, House Human Services & Early Learning Committee

My name is Sylvia Gil and I am testifying on behalf of the Washington State PTA in support of House Bill 1351

The Washington State PTA is in support of increasing access to high-quality preschool and supports on its platform legislation or policies to develop a plan to ensure that all preschool-age children in our state have access to preschool that is:

- High-quality
- o Local
- o Inclusive
- Evidence-based
- o Developmentally appropriate

This legislation is aligned with aims for a plan to increase access to high-quality preschool

- The research is clear to show that high quality preschool can have lasting impacts for k-12 outcomes and life; and impact equity by addressing the opportunity gap at one of the earliest points in a child's life
- As a parent of a preschooler, every day I see my daughter learning new skills and gaining important social and emotional awareness that will provide a critical foundation for school readiness

## The issue for our state is access – our state preschool program is of high-quality, but a low eligibility threshold has created a gap where children are left out

- The gap exists for families that cannot afford tuition for preschool and cannot also qualify for head start or ECEAP
- For families that make above 110 percent of the federal poverty level, paying the full cost of tuition for private preschool would amount to a significant portion of family income and this puts preschool out of reach
- Family income should not impact a child's ability to be ready for kindergarten, but our current kindergarten readiness data shows that readiness is lower for children from families with income at lower income levels; for children from families that are non-lowincome the rate of readiness is still only 61 percent

To ensure that all children have the best opportunity to be prepared for school, we must address this disparity.

## We urge you to pass HB 1351 to allow more children from families along the continuum of income to participate in our state high-quality preschool program
