The Reflections Program is a National PTA arts recognition program that helps students explore their own thoughts, feelings and ideas, develop artistic literacy, increase confidence, and find a love for learning that will help them become more successful not only in school but in life. Students in pre-K through grade 12 create original works of art in response to a theme. Students submit their completed works of art in one, or all, of the available arts categories: Visual Arts, Photography, Literature, Music Composition, Dance Choreography, and Film Production. Local PTAs and councils set their own deadlines for submissions to determine winners

WSPTA GAME DEVELOPMENT COMPETITION



The WSPTA Game Development Competition is a STEM-based program. To expand student inclusion and opportunity, board games are also included. Students in grades 6-12 attending a school with a PTA in good standing may participate and share their knowledge of computer science based on an assigned theme. The purpose is to provide an opportunity for students, either individually or in teams of up to five members, to use their creative talents and express themselves by developing a **computer game or board game**. Students' submissions are judged in the following areas: game of the year, arts and animation, game design, computer programming (code), and computer audio design.

WSPTA ESSAY CONTEST




Essay Contest

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM
